Our Mission

The Fulton County Employees'
Charitable Fund is the vehicle which
provides an opportunity for
employees to make contributions that
promote the well-being of students,
families, and our local community.

The Fund is governed by an employee Board of Directors which operates independently of the Fulton County Schools Board of Education. Its classified and certified employee representatives serve as volunteer Board Members.

Fulton School Employees' Charitable Fund

The Fund is a non-profit, IRS approved, charitable organization administered by the employees of the Fulton County School System. Established in 1989, the Charitable Fund gives employees an opportunity to make tax deductible contributions, to charities of their choice, through a centralized giving fund. Its annual fund-raising drive is the only system-wide campaign for FCS employees.

Employees choose how much and to which charities they wish to contribute during the FCS open enrollment period. Payroll deduction is available for full-time, regular employees with two options:

- Per pay period payroll contributions which are deducted from each paycheck throughout the year.
- One-time contributions which are deducted from the second pay period of the employee's March paycheck. (Personal checks will also be accepted. Checks must be payable to the Fulton Schools Employees' Charitable Fund and be turned in to your campaign coordinator.)

Payroll deduction provides employees with consistent and accurate accounting of the contributions for tax purposes.

The Fulton Schools Employees' Charitable Fund campaign raised \$190,097 for 2020.
